



This week in Foundation stage...



We have got to know the next character in our reading scheme. He is a dog called Floppy.

We introduced the first four sounds - *s, a, t, i* - and have practised writing them, recognising the sound and finding things that start with the same sound.

In maths we focussed on the number 4 and played a simple maths game to find numbers of objects that are the same or different.

On Tuesday Nuthatch made the three bears porridge - Yummy! Robins will do the same next week.

Next week...

We will introduce the next sounds which are *p, n, m, d*

At home...

Have a go at the homework which was sent home yesterday. Ask the children if they can remember the actions and songs which go with the sounds. See how many things you can find around the house beginning with the sounds we introduced this week.
