



This week in Foundation stage...



The children have been practising recognising the names of the Oxford Reading Tree characters - Kipper, Biff, Chip, Floppy, Mum and Dad. Some of them are much easier to read and remember than others! We have focussed on number 6 and becoming more familiar with the shapes and numbers of the Numicon maths equipment.

The children thoroughly enjoyed their *Bear Hunt* in Pamber Forest. The damp weather showed up all the beautiful spiders' webs, the children's behaviour was excellent and everyone had a lot of fun squelching and squerching in the mud.

Next Week...

The children will use the natural materials which they collected in the forest to make pictures. They will photograph their own work using school cameras. They will also use the collection for counting, sorting and other maths activities.
