Help for Families

Food Bank

The school is an agent for the Basingstoke food bank. This means that we can refer families who are in need of some additional financial support so that they can be provided with food and other essentials.

The food bank has a Tadley branch which is held at the Methodist Church on Newchurch Road every Tuesday between 10.30 and 12.30pm. Please contact someone at school if your family is in need and we can provide you with a voucher which you can take along to exchange for supplies. There will also be access to a Citizen's Advice representative who can advise you in times of need. There is a flier being emailed to you all separately with further information.

Energy Grant

There is a grant available to help support with rising energy costs. You may be entitled to make a claim to receive this. Another flier with information about who to contact and how to claim is being emailed to you all.

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School Uniform

You will be aware that the PTA collect good quality school uniform items that children have outgrown and sell them very cheaply to anyone who can make use of them. Children have a habit of growing so fast that their clothes are still in fabulous condition but no longer fit them. Please consider donating any items no longer used by your child to the school. They can be dropped off at the school office. If your child needs any items themselves, feel free to browse the rails under the canopy outside the front of the school office. Take anything that is suitable and pop into the office to pay. Not only does this provide uniform at a fraction of the cost, it helps with recycling and raises a little bit extra for school funds.

We would like to add to the range of items on offer by also accepting any coats that your children have outgrown. If you have any at home that you can donate, please send them in. Thank you for supporting the school and each other in this way.

Sharing Assemblies

We are pleased to be able to start our Sharing Assemblies again from next week. These are held each week starting at 9.10am, on Wednesdays for Key Stage 1 and on Fridays for Key Stage 2. Parents/carers are welcome to attend. Foundation Stage will be joining the assemblies later in the term. We will let you know when their start date is confirmed.

Different children are chosen each week to share some of their work and any news or events they wish to talk about. The aim is that every child will have had a chance to stand up and present to an audience at some point during the academic year and most children are able to present more than once if they would like to.

Parents are not expected to attend every week though you are welcome to come along whenever you can. We try to let you know in advance if your child will be presenting. Usually you would receive a phone call at the start of the week to let you know. We are not able to tell you any earlier as the children are selected based on their most recent work and experiences. We also encourage them to volunteer and, sometimes, our less confident children will decide at the very last minute that they feel able to take part.

We feel it is important to offer the children these opportunities to speak to an audience in a supportive and understanding environment and, in the past, we have been very grateful that everyone in the audience encourages all the children, even if they are not their own.

We hope to see you at one (or more if you can make it!) of our assemblies this year.
